The following pages contain a list of disasters which occurred during the year 1987. The list is not comprehensive and, for the most part, is confined to disasters with reported losses of at least 10 dead or property damage in excess of US \$1 million. However, in some cases when the value of the damage was not reported, but appeared to be significant, or when the criteria above were not met but UNDR0 felt that the damage caused had a severe impact on the economy of the country, such an event was also included.

Disasters ranging from drought, earthquakes, floods and landslides, to storms and volcanic eruptions, as well as mine explosions, train or plane crashes, and road accidents, involving heavy loss of life, are reported, as are large-scale epidemics. Losses arising from armed conflict are excluded.

The inclusion of events in this list does not imply UNDR0 involvement in providing relief assistance. An asterisk (*) signifies the date given is that on which the event was reported.

NOTE: With reference to earthquakes, the open-ended Richter scale measures the magnitude of the event and relates to seismic energy released at the source; the Mercalli scale describes the level of damage inflicted at a particular site, on a 12-point scale.
